

A NOTE ON CLIP-DOWNS & STRESS

If there are too many matts & tangles on your pet they must be clipped down. Professional groomers know how difficult it is on your pet to remove matted fur. It is best to bring your pet in before matts occur but we know this is sometimes unavoidable. You may need to purchase skin relief sprays or apply some of your own several times per day to relieve rashy areas. If you are not comfortable with giving your groomer the discretion to shave out matts in order to make your pets' grooming experience less stressful then be prepared for a hefty grooming bill or having your pet picked up un-groomed. Some dogs & cats absolutely will not tolerate matt splitting & removal and your groomer does not want to put your pet through such a painful & stressful experience.

If your pet is difficult to handle, please use an herbal calmer & socialize your pet by bringing them into the store for treats on non-grooming days. Also have your pet groomed frequently so that they don't have to stay on the grooming table as long. Please remove all harnesses, choke chains, etc. off the dog when you crate them. We are not held responsible if your dog chews on anything left in the crate with them.

EXTRA CHARGES

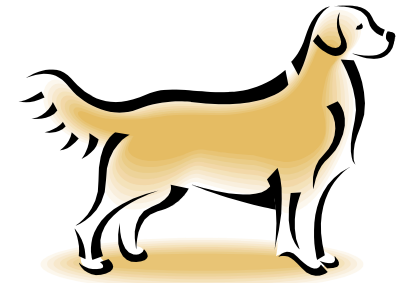
(In addition to grooming charges)

- Matt Removal is an extra \$10 & up
- Untrained/Hard to Handle Dogs are an extra \$10 & up (includes puppies).
- Tear Stain Removal is an extra \$5
- Furminations is an extra \$10 & up
- Flea & Tick Baths are an extra \$7
- Teeth Brushing is an extra \$5
- Matted Dogs are shaved for their comfort & stress, if your dog bites when combing out matts—they will be cut out for your dog's comfort! Bring your dog in every 4 to 6 weeks to prevent extra charges and discomfort to your pet.
- Please take your pet for a potty break before drop-off. There is a \$5 service fee if your pet defecates or pees in the crates.
- If your pet will not be picked up within 1 hour of your pickup call—please let us know so we can make arrangements for a potty break.

Re-call on Cats is every 3 months and most Dogs is every 4 weeks. A 10% discount applies to customers who schedule every 4 weeks. If you cannot make or need to change your grooming appointment, please call us as soon as possible to let us know.

GROOMING SERVICES

We cannot just bathe dogs with matted fur. They must be completely groomed!

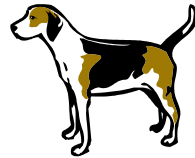
All prices are starting prices and can go up depending on difficulties incurred while grooming.

- Tiny dogs with clipping and scissor finishing start at \$28.²⁵, a bath starts at \$15, Examples are Yorkshire Terriers, Maltese, Long Hair Chihuahuas, Border Terrier, Under 15 lbs,

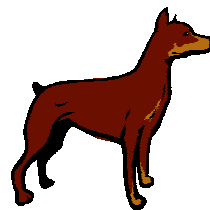


- Small dogs

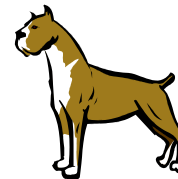
(thick coats) with clipping and scissor finishing start at \$32.²⁵, a bath starts at \$20, Examples are 15 to 30 lbs, Pekingese, Pomeranians, Shih Tzu, Silky, Norwich, Wire Fox, Cairn, etc.



- Medium Dogs (short coats) start at \$20 bath or groom, 30 to 45 lbs, Examples are Shar-pei, Jack Russell, Pitbull, Weimerier, Boston, Dachshund, etc.



- Large Dogs (short coats), start at \$25 for a bath (over 45lbs), Examples are Rottweilers, Labs, Boxers, Danes, Doberman, etc.



- Medium to Large Dogs with long/ thick coats start at \$45, Examples are Golden Retrievers, Bernese, Cocker Spaniels, English Spaniels, Setters, etc.



- Small Dogs with curly coats and skirts start at \$35, a bath starts at \$20, Examples are Poodles, Bichon, Westys, Schnauzers, etc.



- Standard Sized Poodles, Standard Sized Schnauzers, Old

English Sheep Dogs and Bearded Collies start at \$60.



Cats start at \$35 and includes nail trimming, ear cleaning, furmination (undercoat removal) and/or shaving (Lion Cut) with a waterless bath. Cats that are large (over 15lbs), have matted fur, are hard to handle, and/or require a water bath start at \$45.
